## INSTALLATIONS

**⚠ IMPORTANT:** Before installing the YD-V24, make sure:

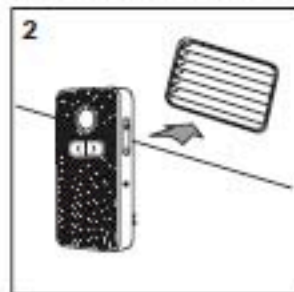
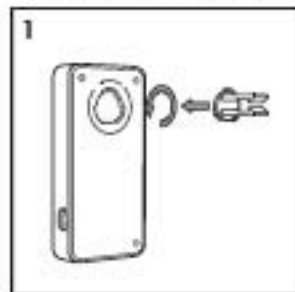
- Vehicle is parked in a safe area
- Car engine is off
- Emergency Brake is set

Your YD-V24 may be installed in your vehicle's air vent or sun visor.

### A. Air Vent Mounting

Follow the steps below to install the YD-V24 to your car's Air Vent:

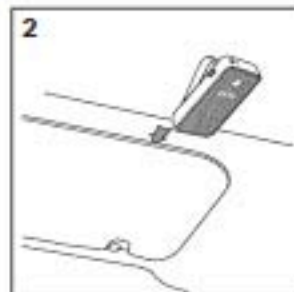
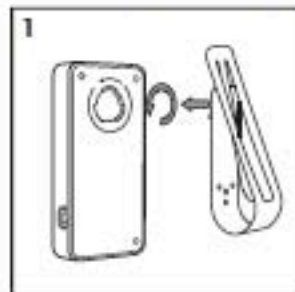
- Attach and secure the vent mount on the back side of the YD-V24
- Slide the mount the YD-V24 to the vehicle's air vent



### B. Sun Visor Mounting

Follow the steps below to install the YD-V24 to your car's sunshade panel:

- Attach and secure the visor Mount to the back side of the YD-V24
- Slide and mount the YD-V24 to the vehicle's sun visor





## BATTERY OPERATIONS

The YD-V24 is equipped with a built-in Li-Polymer battery, which provides better than normal phone battery life span.

**NOTE:** The YD-V24 Hands-Free Mini Speakerphone battery comes pre-charged but it is recommended to charge the battery for 8 hours before using for the first time.

### A. Low Battery Indication

Recharge battery when:

- Indicator light flash twice every 30 seconds
- YD-V24 emits a beeping sound

### B. Charging the Battery

Follow the steps below when charging the YD-V24 Hands-Free Mini Speakerphone:

- Insert the charging cable to the USB charging port of the YD-V24
- Plug the cable to a power port.
- When the device is in charging mode, the red battery indicator light is on indicating that charging is in progress

#### **NOTE:**

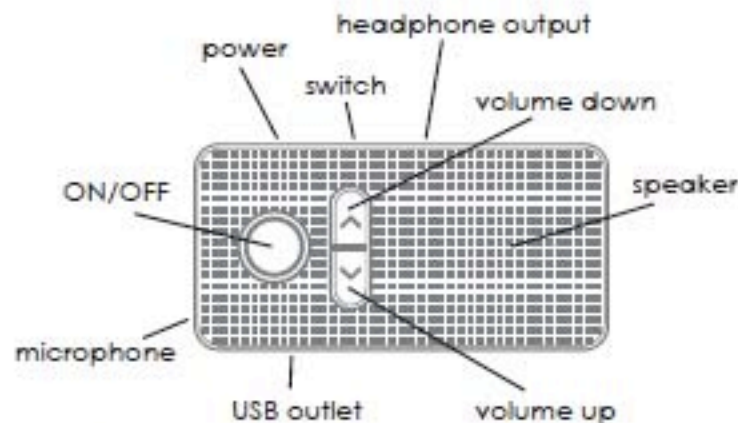
- Standard charge time is around 3 hours
- Battery indicator light will turn off once fully charged

**⚠ IMPORTANT:** Do not leave the YD-V24 Hands-Free Mini Speakerphone charging in the vehicle unattended.

#### **Note:**

- To charge the unit at home, use a 12V DC to AC convert or use a USB Power Outlet
- The device will charge whether the Master Power Switch is in either ON or OFF position

## SPEAKERPHONE OPERATIONS



### A. Power on/off

To turn the YD-V24 on:

- Verify that the Master Power Switch is to the ON position
- Press and hold the ON/OFF button for 6 seconds till you hear beep tone then release
- The blue LED indicator will light up, indicating the standby mode was initiated

To turn the YD-V24 off:

- Press and hold the ON/OFF Button for 3 seconds (in any mode)
- The YD-V24 will shut down
- A long beep sound is heard
- Set the Master Power Switch to OFF position

## B. Pairing/Linking

Pairing Bluetooth® enabled devices like mobile phones with the YD-V24 Hands-Free Mini Speakerphone authorizes the devices to work with each. This step only needs to be performed once.

Before Pairing the YD-V24 Hands-Free Mini Speakerphone:

- Ensure the YD-V24 is fully charged
- Ensure the Bluetooth® on your mobile phone is activated
- Ensure the YD-V24 is in the OFF mode

Follow the steps below to pair your YD-V24 with your mobile phone for the first time:

- Press and hold ON/OFF key for 6 seconds
- The LED indicator alternately blinks red and blue

**Note:** YD-V24 is now in pairing mode


- Turn on your mobile phone

**Note:** The following steps are general procedure; to access Bluetooth® Menu for you mobile phone, please refer to the User Manual.

- Select SET-UP or CONNECT from your mobile phone menu
- Find and select OPTION to discover Bluetooth® devices; establishing a connection may take several minutes
- If found, phone display should indicate YD-V24 device was detected or Select "YD-V24" from the list
- Phone should give you a prompt asking if you want to pair the device
- Select OK or ACCEPT and wait for prompt to enter passkey or PIN
- Enter the code 0000
- Select "OK" to pair and connect the YD-V24 and the handset

**Note:** Under the pairing mode, if the YD-V24 and mobile handset did not successfully pair, follow the steps below to retry pairing:

- Set Master Power Switch OFF and ON
- Power on the YD-V24
- Set off all other Bluetooth® devices before starting the pairing process
- Repeat the pairing instructions from the beginning

 **IMPORTANT:** Pairing information will be lost if the Master Power Switch is set to OFF position. Re-pair the mobile phone with the YD-V24 for Hands-Free functionality.

## C. Call Operations

### A. Making/Receiving Calls

Before you make or receive calls, ensure:

- Bluetooth® connection is established between your YD-V24 and mobile phone
- Battery is fully charged

#### 1. Answering Calls

**Note:** Calls may be answered through the mobile phone

To answer calls via the YD-V24:

- The YD-V24 will ring or emit a beep sound when there is an incoming call
- Press the ON/OFF button when ring tone is heard

#### 2. Rejecting Calls

- The YD-V24 will ring or emit a beep sound when there is an incoming call
- Press and hold the ON/OFF button for 2 seconds to reject a call



### 3. Terminating a Call

**Note:** Calls may be ended through the mobile phone

To end calls via the YD-V24:

- Press the ON/OFF button

### 4. Last Number Re-dial

To call last number dialed or calls register:

- Press the ON/OFF button twice

### 5. Making a Call

**Note:** The YD-V24 doesn't have a numeric keyboard to support dialing.

Use your Bluetooth® mobile phone to make outgoing calls.

- Ensure the YD-V24 is paired with your Bluetooth® mobile phone before dialing
- Dial the number using your mobile phone key pad
- Press the call button of your mobile phone to make a call

### 6. Canceling a Call

After dialing a number but cannot go through or you don't want to continue with the call, you may cancel the action:

- Press the ON/OFF button

### 7. Interchanging YD-V24 and Handset

You may interchange the call between your handset and YD-V24 while on a call

- Press the switch key twice
- The call will be transferred to your YD-V24 unit from your mobile phone or vice versa

### 8. Adjusting the Volume

To adjust the volume while during a call:

- Press VOLUME UP key to increase speaker volume
- Press VOLUME DOWN key to decrease speaker volume

**Note:** The above-mentioned functions are only applicable to the mobile phones which support the Bluetooth® Hands-Free function. Please refer to your Bluetooth® mobile phone user manual for appropriate applications.

### 9. Mute/Un-mute Functions:

To mute the YD-V24 during an active call:

- Press switch key for 2 seconds
- The YD-V24 will emit a beep
- The YD-V24 is now in mute mode

To un-mute the YD-V24 during an active call:

- While headset is in mute mode, press switch key for 2 seconds
- The YD-V24 will emit a beep
- The YD-V24 is no longer in mute mode

### D. Listening to Music

You can listen to music from your mobile phone through your YD-V24:

- Ensure the Bluetooth® link is established between your A2DP handset and YD-V22
- Set music player using your mobile phone
- You may plug in an earphone into the 3.5 jack on your YD-V24

#### Automatic Switching between Music and Calls

If there is an incoming call while streaming music from your handset via the stereo, music will automatically pause and switch to the call. Music streaming will resume after completion of the call.

**Note:** This function is accessible for handsets that are A2DP enabled.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Turn off the YD-V24 when not in use
- Do not let the YD-V24 be in contact with liquid as it is not waterproof. Avoid putting it in places where there is excessive moisture and humidity.
- Do not expose the YD-V24 to direct sunlight nor place in areas with high temperature, as it may result in an explosion
- If the YD-V24 is not in use for a prolonged period, store in a cool, dry place, free from moisture, humidity and dust
- Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean the YD-V24
- Do not expose the YD-V24 to contact with sharp objects as this will cause scratching and damage
- Do not stick anything inside the YD-V24 as this may damage internal components
- Do not attempt to disassemble the YD-V24, as it does not contain serviceable components
- Only charge the YD-V24's built-in battery in accordance with the instructions of this user guide
- Do not disassemble the device as it may expose you to dangerous voltages or other risks. Incorrect reassembly can cause electric shock when the YD-V24 is subsequently used
- Avoid charging the YD-V24 in extremely high or low temperatures
- It's recommended to charge the YD-V24 immediately whenever low battery Poweris encountered to prolong durability & standby time of battery

## TROUBLE SHOOTING

If you are unable to hear the person on the other line clearly, do the following steps while conversation is in ongoing:

- Adjust the volume to maximum in your YD-V24 or
- Request the person on the other line to adjust his/her mobile phone volume to maximum

If there is a strong echo resounding from the person on the other line:

- Transfer the call to mobile phone.
- If echo disappeared, transfer the call again from mobile phone to YD-V24 and lower the loudspeaker volume until echo is eliminated.
- If the echo still remains, this means the echo is generated by the network service provider or mobile phone itself.

If the speaker volume of the YD-V24 is too low or too high and seems impossible to adjust it:

- Adjust the volume directly on the phone.
- Fine tune it using the volume control of the YD-V24

If you are unable to connect your speakerphone and mobile handset, please try the following:

- Ensure the YD-V24 is paired with your mobile handset/PC & battery is fully charged
- Ensure your mobile handset's Bluetooth® feature is activated. Please refer to your mobile handset user guide for specific instructions
- If your computer does not have built-in Bluetooth® capability, you will need to install a Bluetooth® USB Adapter to utilize the Speakerphone. Follow instructions for installing adapter in your computer.
- Ensure the YD-V24 is within a maximum of 10 meters of your mobile handset(s) or Bluetooth® enabled device and there are no obstructions, such as wall or other electronic devices, in between as it may cause interference transmission
- If all the above steps do not resolve your problem, please remove the battery for a while
